A. Typically gas water heaters last 8-10 years. If your water heater is noisy, corroded along the bottom, or if you are getting a lot of rusty water, it may be time to replace it. Also, when hot water heaters let go, they often rupture and can cause a lot of water damage if gone unnoticed.

Q. What are my options in replacing a water heater?

A. There are On Demand water heaters and Indirect-fired water heaters, both are fuel efficient.
